In the **Study Book**, we find some of the most authoritative voices on the figure and career of this camera genius.

The image of the Afghan girl opens the door to McCurry's essence in a case with an unmatched brilliance.

This portrait marks its 40th anniversary in 2024, as it was in 1984 when McCurry found **Sharbat Gula**, the name of the girl, in the midst of the Afghan war, when she was only 12 years old.

All this makes *Capturing the Soul* a unique opportunity to get closer to the soul of Steve McCurry and an unprecedented perspective on his essence, becoming his most intimate and exclusive narrative.

In the **Art Book** of *Capturing the Soul*, McCurry documents his vision of the world in which he lives, captivating viewers not only with the beauty of his work but also with the deep and personal way he evokes emotions.

Through **40 original photographs**, personally selected by the artist, dating from 1984 to 2019.

We find **29 horizontal images and 11 vertical ones**, printed on the highest quality photographic paper. These photos span 19 countries, filled with culture, emotion, and color, printed using Durst laser technology on Crystal Archive Fuji paper with a matte finish, and protected with translucent Fedrigoni paper, consolidating this Art Book as a must-have piece for photography lovers.

The figure of Steve McCurry as the true protagonist

This piece, besides offering the most representative original photographs of Steve McCurry's career, tells us what the photographer is like in his private life.

Bonnie McCurry, the artist's sister, provides a chronological reflection of the author's life through his images. Meanwhile, journalist **Antoni Ortí** explores McCurry's figure as a professional photographer, highlighting his reference techniques and artistic concerns.

The artist analyzes the 40 photographs one by one, sharing personal anecdotes and memories, revealing the passage of time and his sensitivity, helping the viewer to better understand the moment in which each image was captured.
